Dan Foley completed his PhD (2015) in synthetic organic chemistry at the University of Leeds (UK) working with Profs S. Marsden and A. Nelson, and was subsequently awarded an EPSRC Doctoral Prize Fellowship (2015–2017). He then carried out a Marie Skłodowska-Curie European Fellowship, focused on synthesis and biological investigations of pseudo-natural products, with Prof H. Waldmann at the Max Planck Institute of Molecular Physiology, Dortmund, Germany. Dan joined the University of Canterbury (New Zealand) as a Lecturer in organic chemistry in 2018, and was promoted to Senior Lecturer in 2022. His research interests focus on the development of new synthetic methods of value to molecular discovery and medicinal chemistry.
